- Be careful with personal contact.

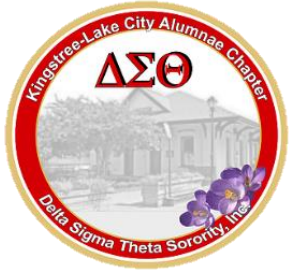

Zoom Meeting Etiquette: A Concise List of Do's and Don'ts



Do's:

1. **Test Your Equipment:** Ensure your camera, microphone, and internet connection are working before the meeting. Also, make sure that your name is listed correctly on your profile.
2. **Join on Time:** Log in a few minutes early to avoid disrupting the meeting. You can log in at **8:30 am** and the Tech Team will open the forum at **8:45 am**.
3. **Mute When You Are Not Speaking:** Keep your microphone on mute when you're not talking to reduce background noise.
4. **Use a Professional Background:** Opt for a clean, non-distracting background (or use a virtual one if needed).
5. **Dress Appropriately:** Wear business attire as you would in a physical meeting.
6. **Engage with the Speaker: CAMERAS MUST BE ON DURING RITUALISTIC OPENING AND CLOSING. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE MEETING AND CAN REJOIN AFTERWARDS!!!** Nod, smile, or use appropriate body language to show attentiveness.
7. **Use the Chat or Raise Hand Feature:** When you need to speak or ask a question, use the proper Zoom tools to avoid interruptions.
8. **Look into the Camera:** Make virtual eye contact when speaking, which helps engage with the audience.
9. **Prepare Materials in Advance:** Have any necessary documents or presentations ready to share with the Tech Team at least 3 days before chapter meeting.
10. **Use Good Lighting:** Make sure your face is well-lit and visible.
11. **Stay Focused:** Pay attention, avoid multitasking, and actively contribute to the meeting.

Don'ts:

1. **Don't Interrupt:** Wait to be recognized by the chair before speaking.
2. **Avoid Background Noise: ONLY MEMBERS OF KLC DST AND VALIDATED MEMBERS OF DST SHOULD BE PRESENT!!!** Don't join the meeting in noisy environments or without muting when background noise is present.
3. **Don't Use Distracting Backgrounds:** Avoid busy or inappropriate virtual backgrounds.
4. **Don't Move Around:** Stay stationary to prevent a distracting or shaky video feed.
5. **Don't Eat During the Meeting:** Unless it's a casual or long meeting with designated breaks, avoid eating on camera.
6. **Don't Engage in Side Conversations:** Refrain from having private chats or conversations while the meeting is in progress.
7. **Don't Forget to List Your Name Correctly on Your Profile:** If joining late, introduce yourself quickly in the chat.
8. **Don't Share Personal Information in the Chat:** Keep the chat professional and relevant to the meeting.
9. **Don't Ignore the Host's Instructions:** Follow any guidelines or rules set by the host for the meeting.
10. **Avoid Technical Troubles Mid-Meeting:** Ensure all updates and equipment are tested before the meeting to prevent technical difficulties.
